INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED STRICTLY

- a) As per Government directives, students are required to download Arogya Setu App and keep it in active mode all the time.
- b) All students on arrival shall directly report to the screening centre at JNU hospital. No excuses will be entertained.
- c) Day scholars who have been residing in Jaipur shall report to the screening centre with the self declaration forms filled and will get screened for symptoms. They shall get an RTPCR test done from ICMR approved lab (Max. 48 hours) prior to their arrival at college.
- d) All hostel residents, who are arriving in Jaipur from other cities, shall get an RTPCR test report from ICMR approved lab done not earlier than 48 hours.
- e) All students who are reporting from other states or cities and who stay at accommodations outside the campus shall also submit RTPCR test report done from ICMR approved labs done within 48 hours of arrival.
- f) Upon arrival at the screening centre or at any time in the future, if a student displays/develops symptoms, he or she may be subjected to RTPCR testing as decided by the Medical Task Force.
- g) If students arriving at the campus as in point No. c, d & e do not produce RTPCR report upon arrival, **they will not be allowed entry into the college** or hostel until they are tested either on campus upon payment [which must be cleared] or any other place of their choice.
- h) In case any student is tested **upon arrival, the student will have to be quarantined** in the campus on payment or may make their own arrangement till the reporting of the test and subsequent clearance accordingly.
